Veterinary Services



All animals that enter the Potsdam Humane Society receive a high level of care. Prior to adoption Pets are:

- Spayed & Neutered
- Microchipped
- Receive Age Appropriate Vaccinations
- Checked and treated for internal and external parasites, and kept on monthly preventative
- Leukemia Tested (Cats)
- Heartworm Tested (Dogs) and kept on monthly preventative

Foster Care

PHS has many generous volunteers that offer up their time and home to foster animals until they can be placed for adoption. A majority of the animals are healing from illnesses or other medical issues. From spring to fall, many families foster litters of kittens so they can grow up in a home setting instead of a cage at the shelter. PHS even has a foster families for feral cats and kittens to tame them so they can be adopted! We are very fortunate and could not help so many animals without a great group of dedicated foster families!

Since October 2014, volunteers from the Potsdam Humane Society, and other North Country Non-profits, have raised over \$60,000 by participating in a unique fundraising opportunity provided by the catering service Centerplate, a hospitality partner of the NYS Olympic Regional Development Authority in Lake Placid. Potsdam Humane Society contracts with 12 townships, each with an Animal Control Officer or Dog Control Officer for the town. These officers support the community with around-the-clock service. By contracting with PHS, Animal Control supports animal welfare and keeps community members safe.








In March of 2018, the Potsdam Humane Society was awarded \$178,895.00 from NY State Agriculture & Markets Companion Animal Capital Fund for a \$238,525.00 improvement and expansion project. PHS was one of 14 animal shelters and humane societies across the state which have been awarded



funding through the fund totaling nearly \$5 million. These competitive grants were awarded to shelters based on need and the readiness of projects. The Companion Capital Fund is the first statefunded program in the nation to support critical improvement projects in New York animal shelters.

a year round exercise and training area for pets and a community room. The original building will see critical improvements that will improve and expand care services for the animals that find their way to our shelter. We will re-purpose, rehabilitate, and renovate various spaces throughout the shelter, including the heating and cooling systems, ventilation systems, and expanding space for adoptable cats.

The new annex will be dedicated to former shelter volunteer and fallen U.S. Army Specialist Chad Fuller, who died in the line of duty in 2003.

Some improvements and modifications started summer of 2018, while the official groundbreaking is slated for February 2019.

In the meantime, PHS is raising funds to make up the difference of the cost of the project.
