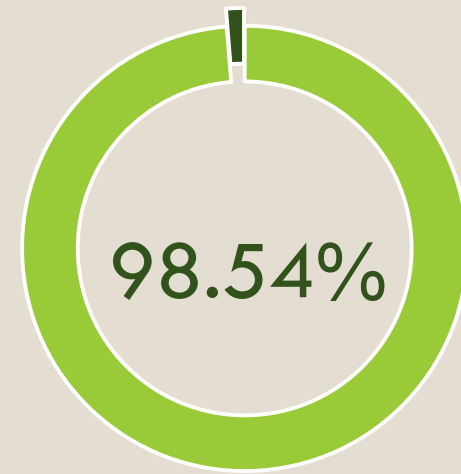

2019 Save Rate



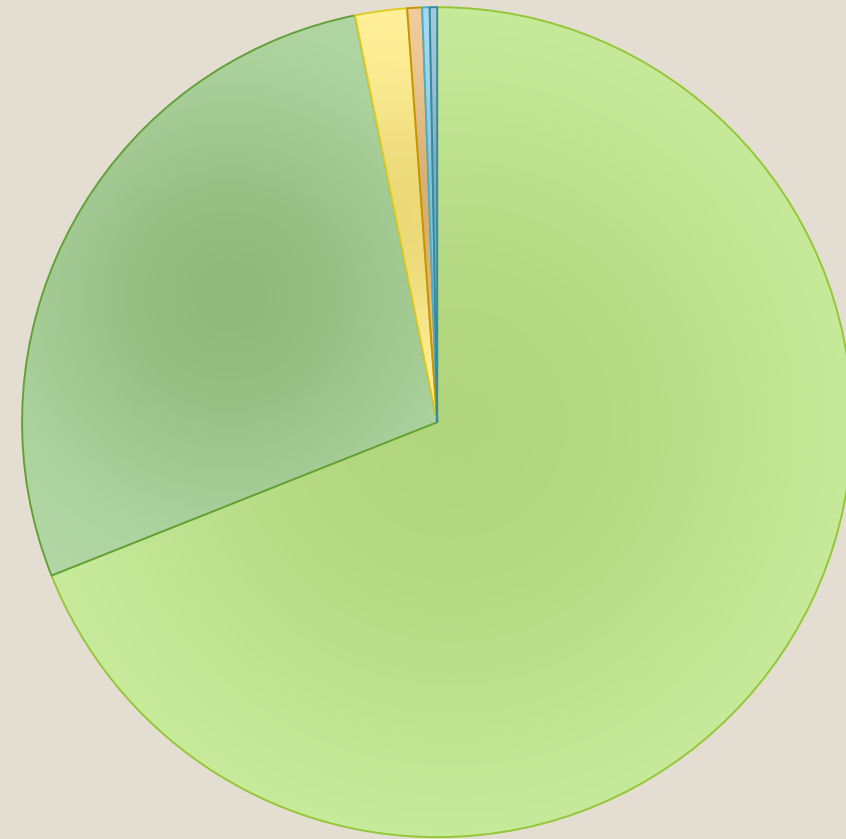


SHELTER STATISTICS

PET SERVICES

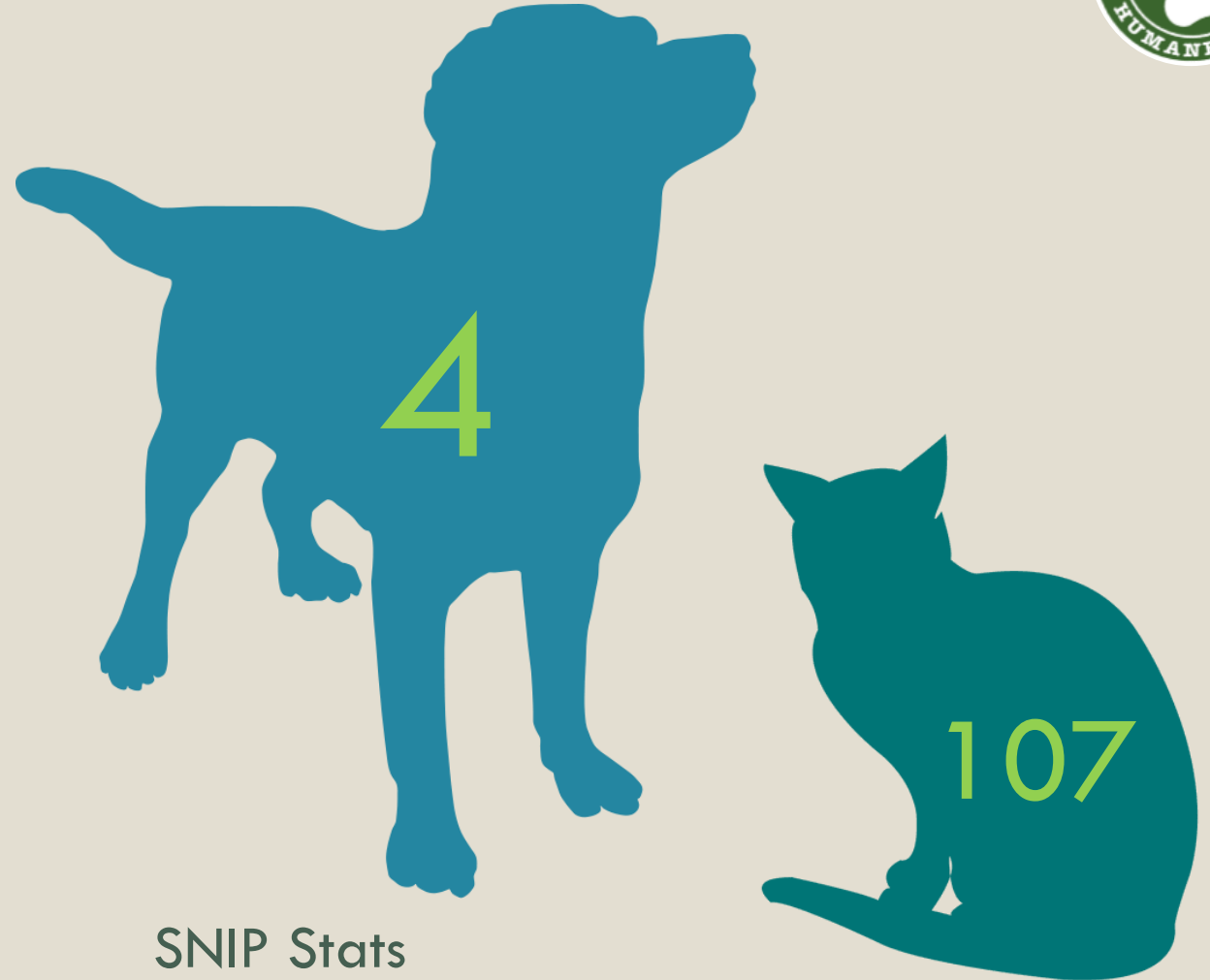
LOST & FOUND.

When a pet is lost, PHS provides a safe place, food, and care for the animal while we work to reunite them with their families.

Thanks to you and social media, PHS was able to get **86** pets back home which included **17** Cats, **68** Dogs, and **1** Rabbit.

LOW COST SPAY & NEUTER.

PHS performed **111** low-cost spay and neuter surgeries to families in 2019 through the PHS Project SNIP Program.

107 Cats and 4 Dogs were spayed and neutered at low cost for North Country families.



LENGTH OF STAY

When an animal comes to the Potsdam Humane Society, we believe that every animal should stay just as long as they need to in order to get the care they need and be adopted into a great home without delays.

For some animals, the process may be quick, for others that may be sick or injured, it is a longer journey. The average length of stay in 2019 for cats is 45 days and 39 days for dogs! This is down from 2018, as the length of stay for cats was 52.5 days and 48.7 days for dogs.

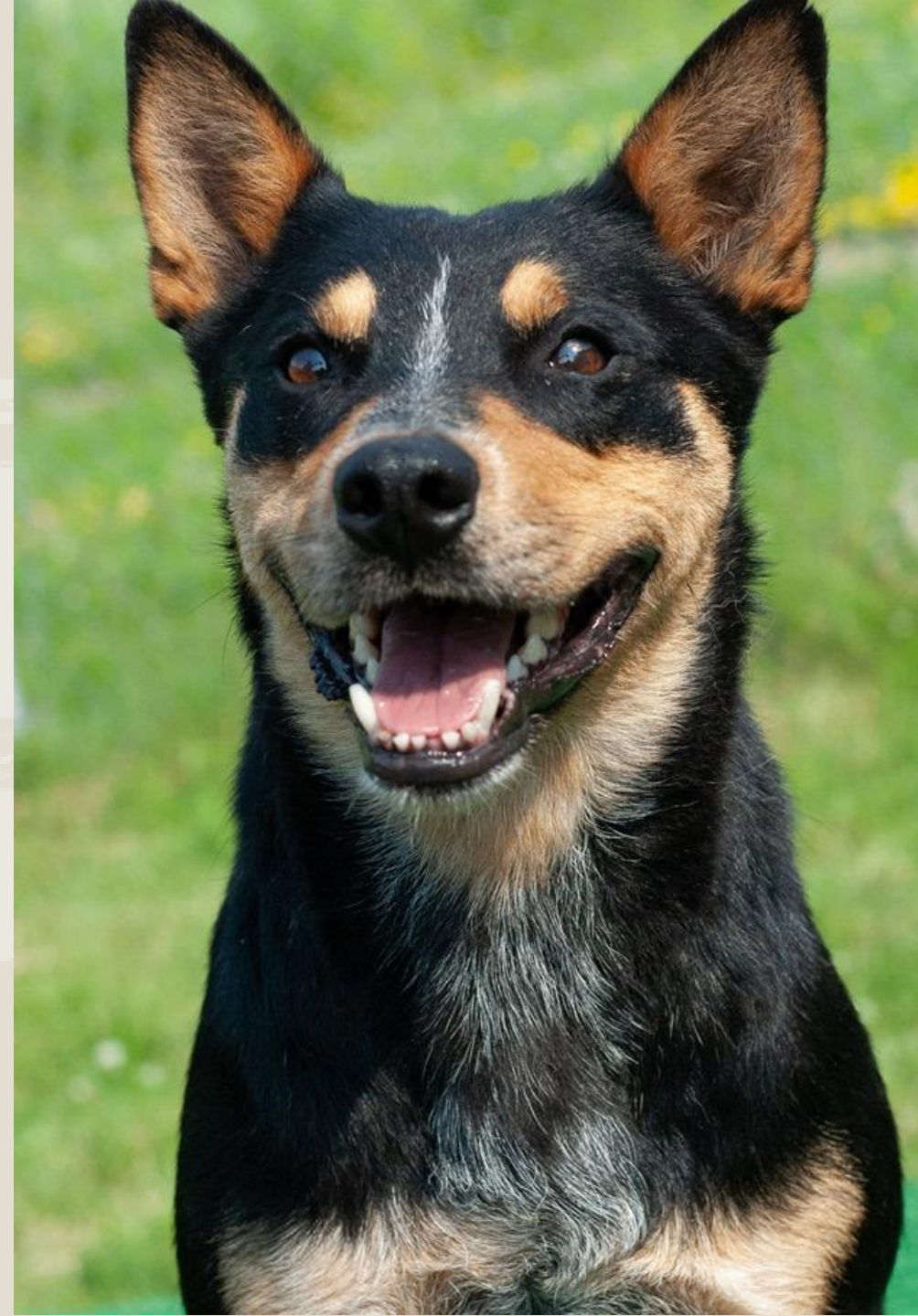

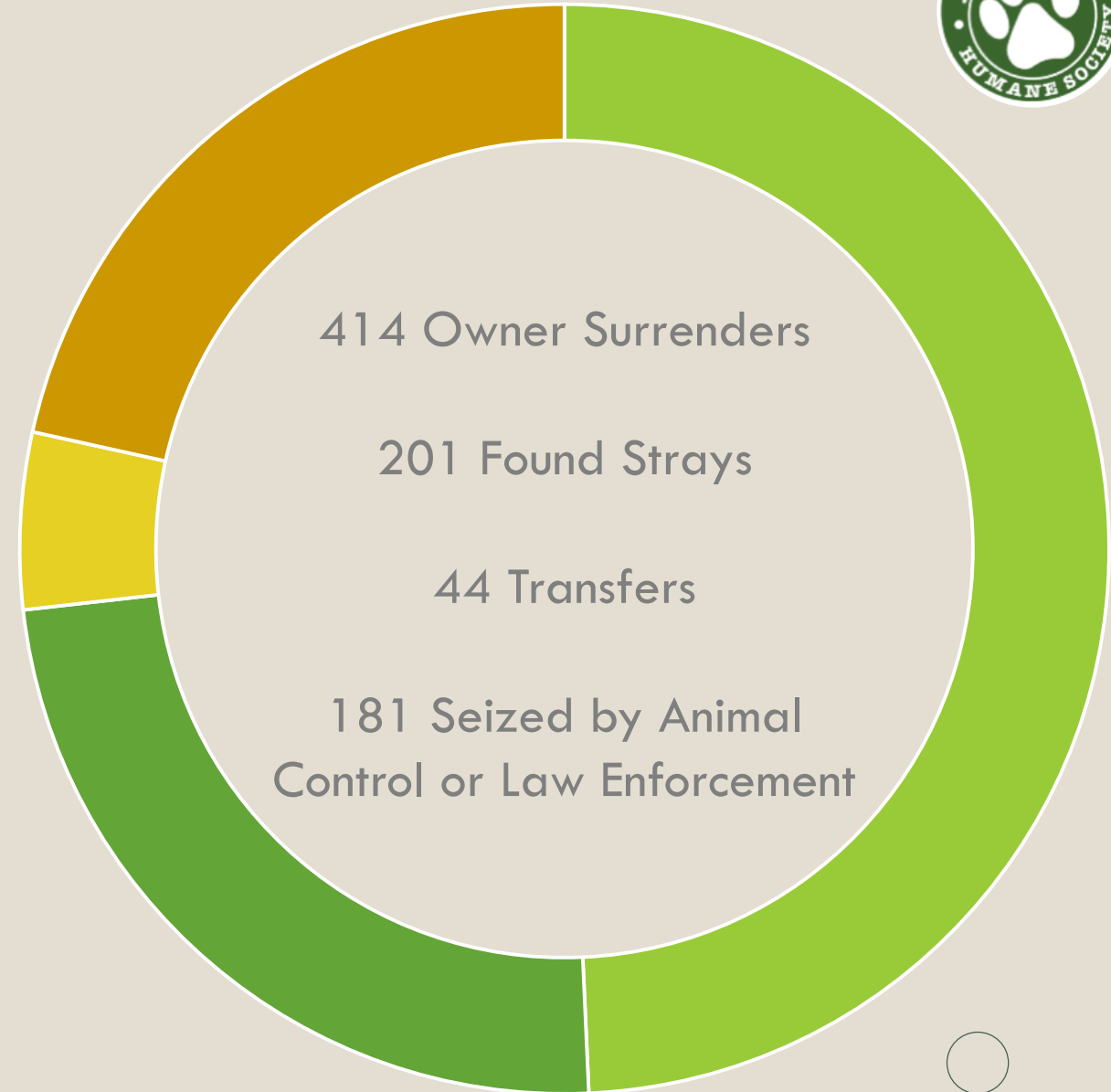

Animal Lovers and Community Members braved the rainy weather for the Potsdam Humane Society's 10th Annual Strut Your Mutt raising almost \$10,000 to help with animal medical costs and assist PHS as it strives to be a no-kill shelter. Many families and dogs strutted their stuff on the trails of Horsefeathers Haunts. Local businesses donated over 50 prizes for participants. Nearly 100 vendors displayed and sold items in the craft show indoors at Pine Street Arena. Concessions by Pastimes, free face painting, the North Country Crusaders, themed basket raffles, K-Stone Acres and Rescue's petting zoo, and SafeChild ID's by the SLC Sheriff's Department. The arena also hosted the Clarkson and Potsdam Garden Club's Annual Plant Sale. The annual event is always held on the first Saturday in May in Potsdam.

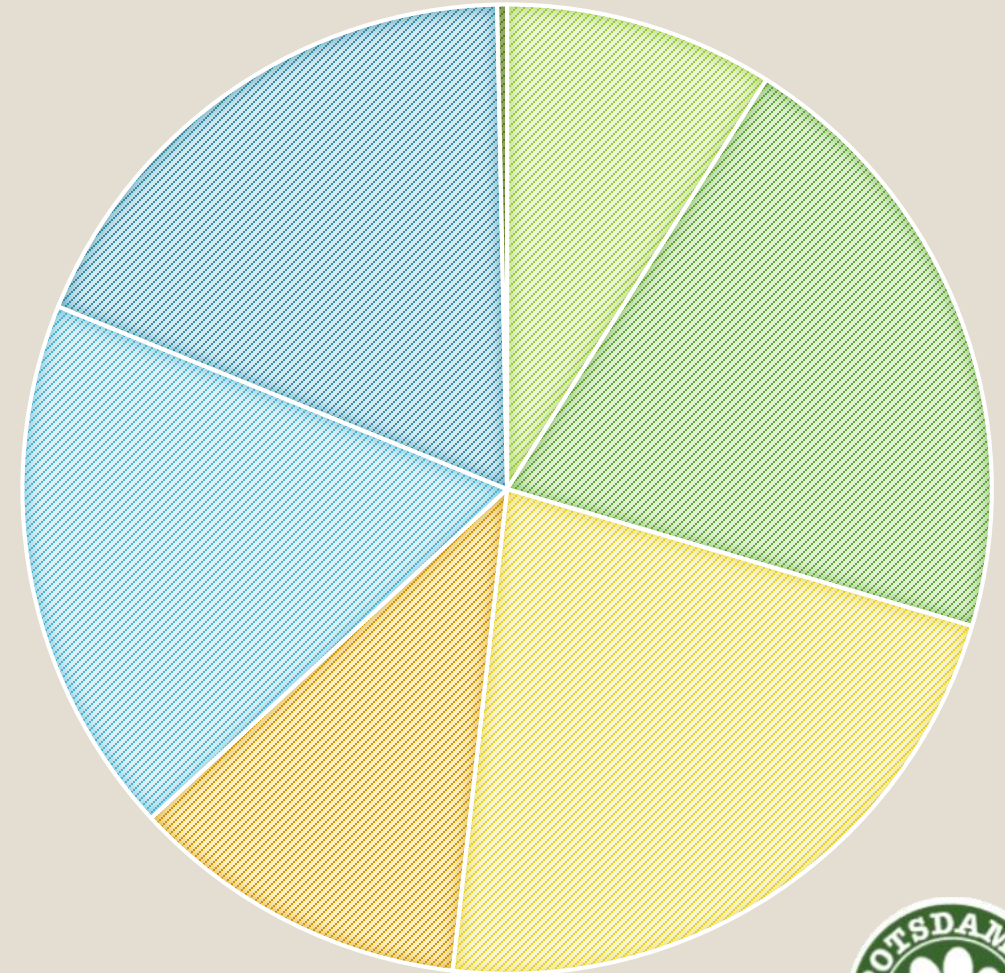

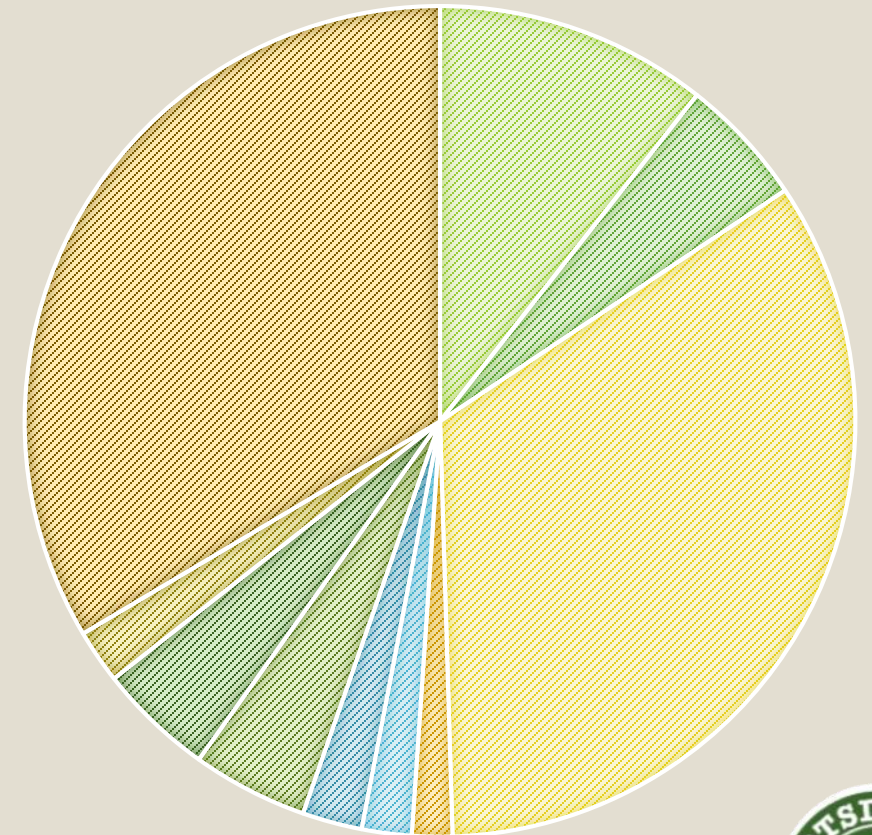

EXPANSION PROJECT

Potsdam Humane Society was joined by NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets to break ground on a 1,600 square foot expansion project of its our existing shelter. The \$238,525 project includes an annex that will house year-round exercise and training area for pets, community room and office. The exercise areas will ensure regular socialization and physical activity for dogs when access to outdoor areas is limited during winter months. Our original building will also see critical improvements made to support animal care. PHS was awarded \$178,895 from the State's Companion Animal Capital Fund in 2018.

Community members and elected officials came together for a dedication ceremony of the new annex to former shelter volunteer and fallen U.S. Army Specialist Chad Fuller, who died in the line of duty in 2013.

A ceremony hosted by the Potsdam American Legion immediately following the groundbreaking, Chad's family was presented a personalized *Honor and Remember Flag* to honor Chad's patriotic unwavering dedication, to remember his selfless sacrifice, and to recognize the enduring sacrifice of the Fuller family.

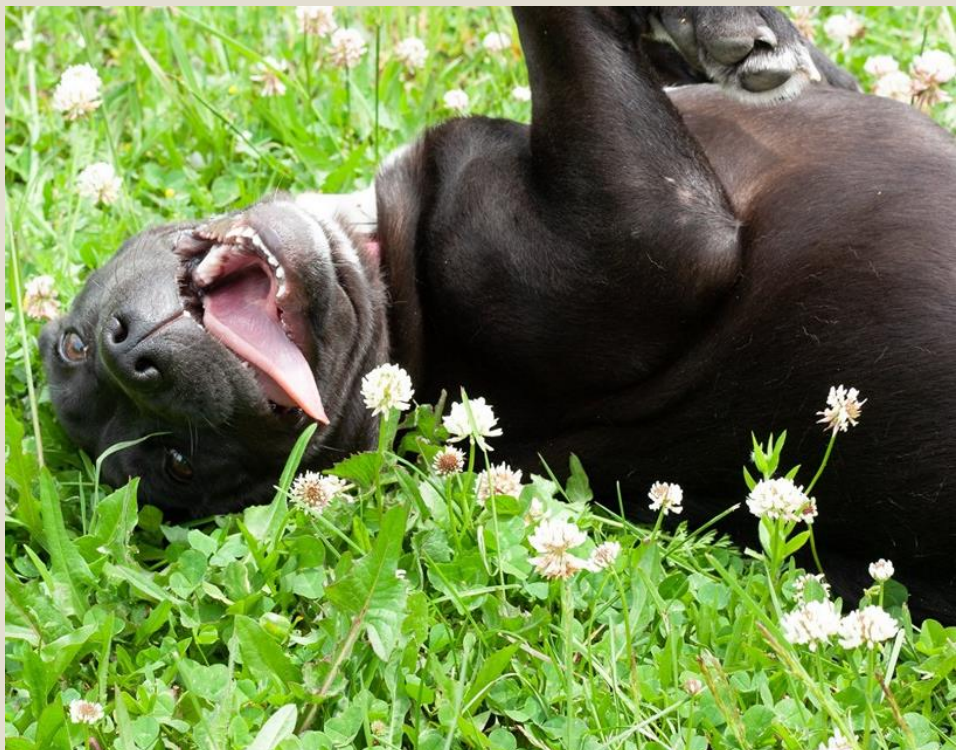

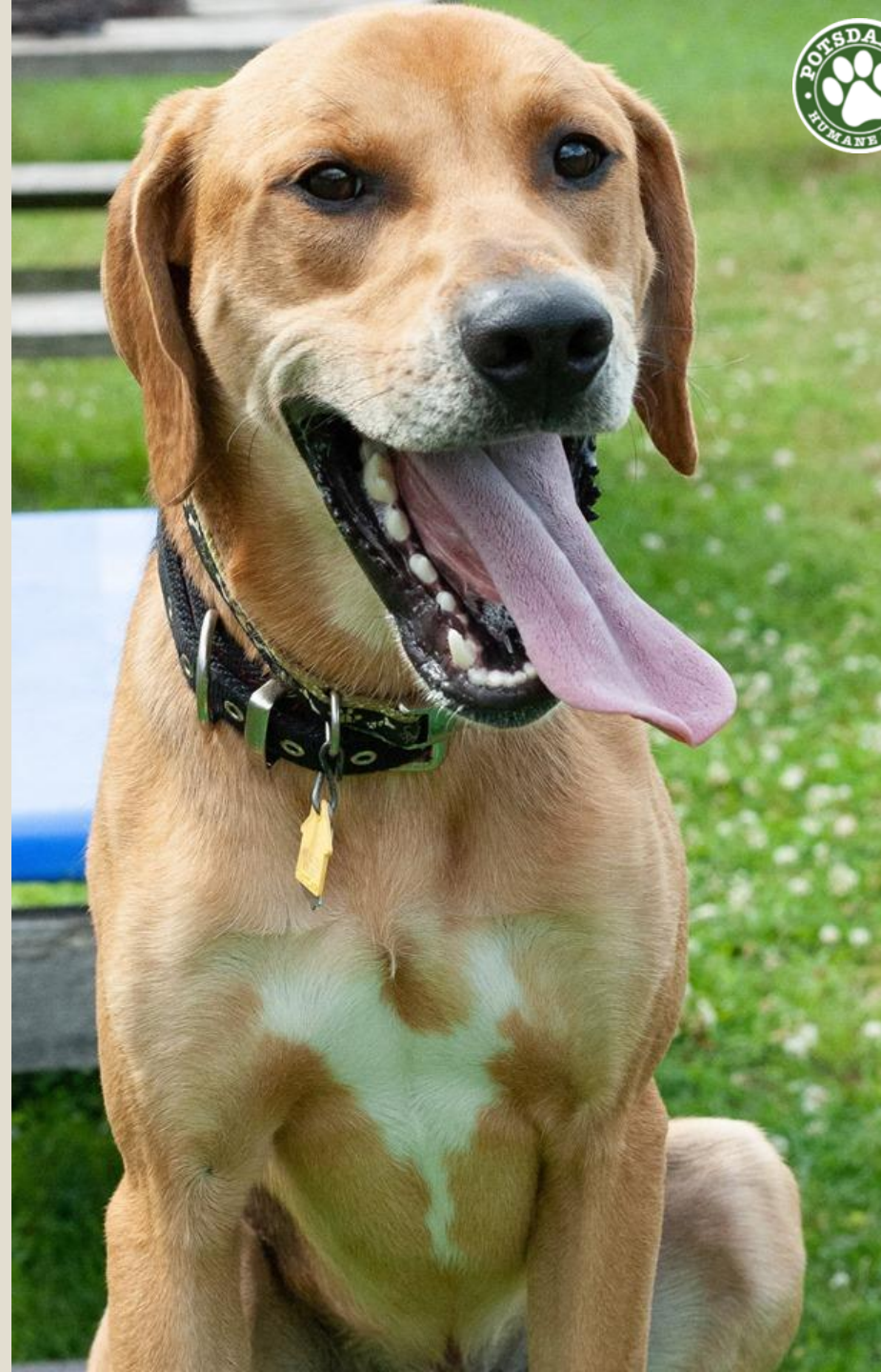
